

# Red Rose Classic Tournament Rules

## Registration

All entry fees received are deposited immediately and refunded within four weeks of your team's non-acceptance. You will have the option of paying via Check, Visa, Mastercard, Paypal, and Venmo. We have a registration form that will need to be filled out and submitted along with payment.

Following items are needed for team registration:

- 2017/18 Certified State Stamped Team Roster (1 copy)
- Medical Release forms for each player. Your generic team/club medical release are acceptable
- 2017/18 Player Pass for each player (must have picture)
- Secondary Player will be accepted as part of your original roster this year
- Permission to Travel Form (if necessary from your state, please check with your state association. If your state association requires you to provide a permission to travel, you need to bring the appropriate paperwork that has been submitted to your state. Please check with your state associations office to see if this is the paperwork you will need.

## Field Locations:

U9-U10 Boys and Girls will be played at Red Rose Arena Backyard. 3549 Hempland Rd. Lancaster, PA 17601

U11-U14 Boys and Girls will be played at Pequea Valley High School. 4033 E Newport Rd, Kinzers, PA 17535

Each site will have a Headquarters Tent to check in.

## Laws of The Game:

- All Games shall be played in accordance with FIFA laws and U. S. Soccer rules regarding the use of U.S. Soccer. Registered referees only will be allowed.

## Duration of Games

- All games will be played with a running clock. If a serious injury were to occur, the referee may stop the clock. All decisions of this nature are made by the official and are final.
- U9-U10 Will play forty-minute (40) games with twenty-minute (20) halves.
- U11-U15 will play fifty-minute (50) games with twenty-five-minute (25) halves.

## Field and Game Equipment

- Players must wear numbers on the back of their uniforms and these numbers shall coincide with those listed on team's official tournament roster.
- Players are required to wear shin guards in accordance with FIFA Laws of the Game.

- The designated home team shall change to alternate uniform color if a conflict exists. Home team will have 1st half kickoff and away team will have 2<sup>nd</sup> half kickoff.

### **Substitutions**

- Unlimited substitutions may be made, with the referee's permission, in accordance with FIFA Laws of the Game.

### **Game and Score Reporting**

- Field Marshal will ensure that the game and the report forms are properly completed and that a signature is obtained with the score of the games recorded.
- All Brackets and Scores will be available for viewing at Tournament Headquarters.

### **Conduct for Players and Parents**

- Players will demonstrate sportsmanship on and off the field. This includes exercising self-control, graciously accepting the outcome of the games, and treating all players and fans with courtesy and respect.
- Players will demonstrate respect for all players and coaches in language and behavior. Profanity, violence and abuse of any nature will not be tolerated. Derogatory language, including that directed at a person's race, ethnicity, gender or physical appearance, will not be tolerated.
- Players will demonstrate respect for officials in their interactions with them and by accepting their decisions. Insulting comments, arguing, gestures and profanity directed at officials will not be tolerated.
- Parents encourage sportsmanship by example. Remind fellow parents if they get inappropriately carried away with their emotions during the game. Accept these reminders graciously when offered by other parents.
- Parents be supportive, unconditionally! Accept wins and losses.
- Parents support the officials, do not criticize vocally during games. Leave any issues with the game officials to your coach.

### **Inclement Weather**

- In case of inclement weather, the Tournament Committee will have the authority and discretion to change the games as follows.
  - o Relocate or reschedule any game(s).
  - o Change the duration of any game(s).
  - o Cancel one of the three games played in one day tournament setting.
  - o In the event that schedules need to be changed, notice will be sent via email from the tournament director.
  - o Refund Policy: In the event of unforeseen weather that would result in us cancelling the tournament, Red Rose Classic will refund a portion of the application fee minus any necessary fixed cost of running the tournament.
